Our Half Term Topic

Our theme this half term is, 'The Art of Food.' We will be focusing on the Digestive System and Teeth in Science, Still Life in Art and Design and will also be making topic links with Music and Computing.

Maths

This half term we will be studying Roman Numerals; Fractions and Decimals; Position and Direction; and Area. Year 4 will continue to have a Mental Maths Test every Friday and should continue to learn their times tables regularly.

English

Learning in English will be based around Dilemma Stories, Poems and Non-Chronological Reports. In Guided Reading we are studying the text, 'Who was Roald Dahl,' by True Kelley. We will also be having weekly grammar sessions.
