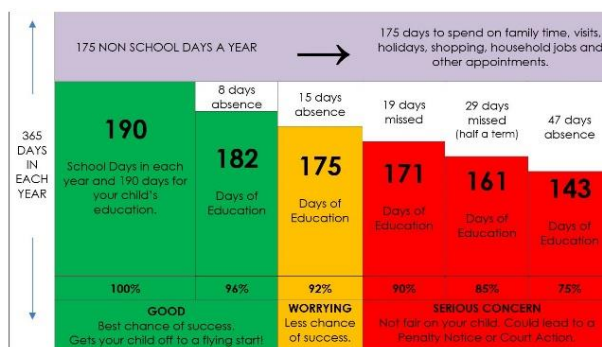

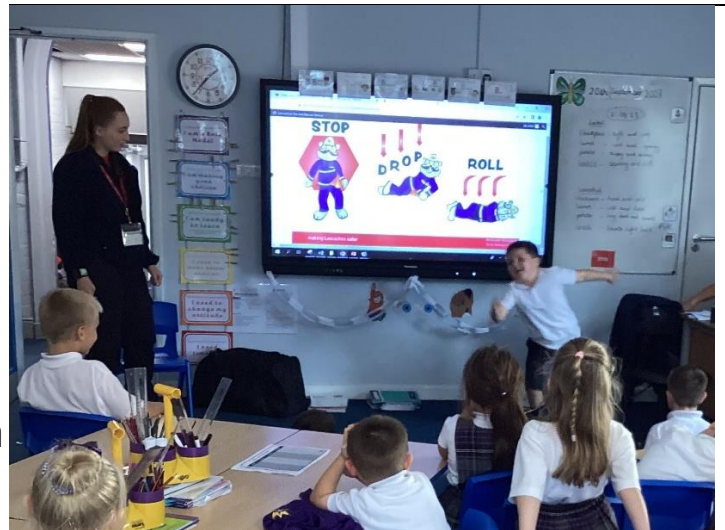
Little Saints try out Little Foodies @BoothsCountry

Does your child struggle at school?

Lancashire SENDIAS have a 6-week course for parents and carers to help them understand more about the special needs process in Lancashire.

This will be a face-to-face course run in West Lancashire by Trinity Special Needs Advice Partnership with the Lancashire Children and Family Wellbeing Service

We understand how challenging it can feel for a parent or carer of a child or young person who is struggling with their mental health. Managing those emotions, understanding warning signs, communicating your concerns and attending to your child or young persons mental health and wellbeing, alongside your own; can feel overwhelming.

Our parent workshop aims to support YOU.

It includes:

- Discussing signs and symptoms of poor mental health.
- Reflective practice and self care.
- Where to go for help and support.
- A wellbeing tool kit for you and your child or young person to work through together following the workshop.
