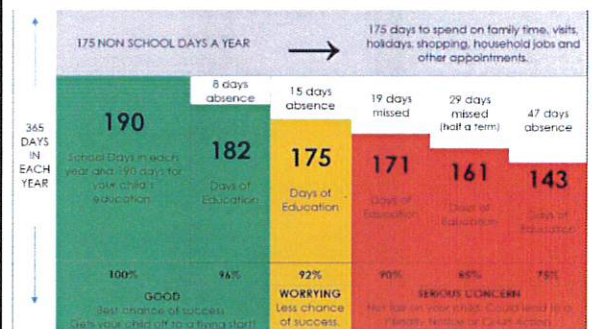

Year 6: Nathan for his incredibly hard work in improving his handwriting. Evangeline for always listening intently and enthusiastically to our class novel.




Thank you!
