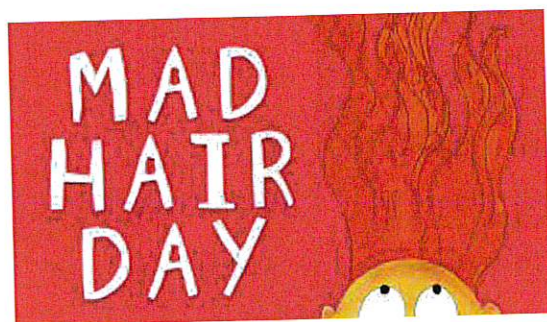


FOS (Friends of School) say thank you for attending their meeting, it was great to see new faces and get some good ideas for future activities and events.

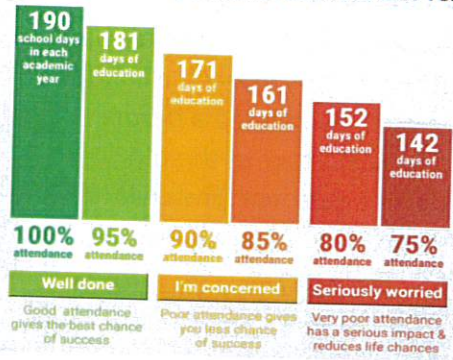

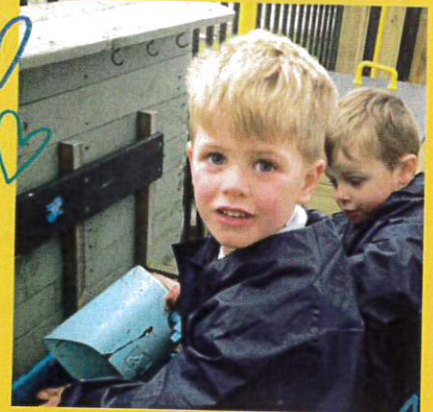


## Bikeability
