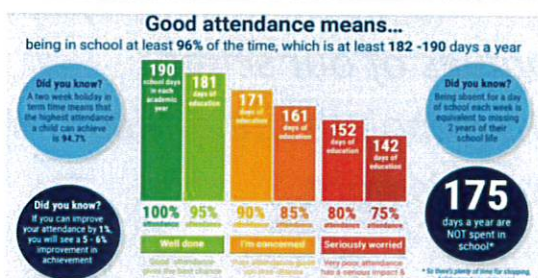

*Thank you, God, for the children who will be representing their classes on the School Council and will discuss and decide on important matters that will affect us all.*

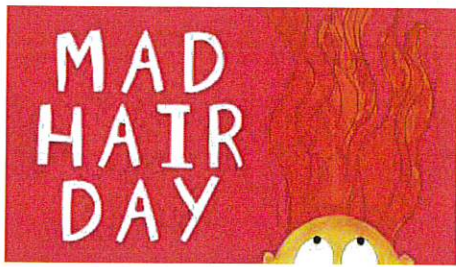
*We pray that during meetings all the members of the council will be heard, their suggestions valued, and the decisions they make will be based on the core values of our school.*
