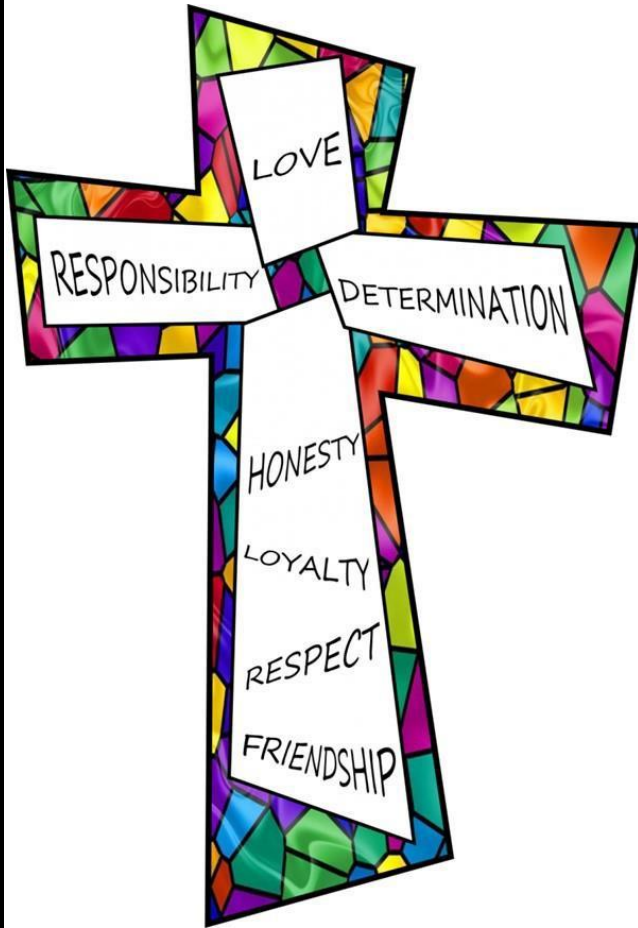



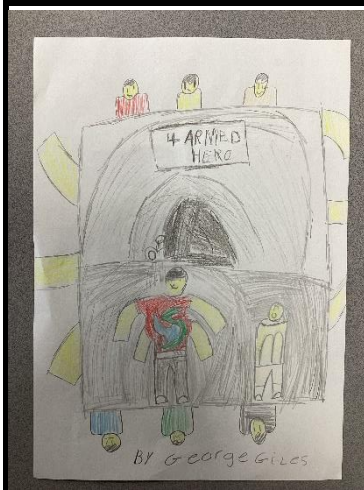
We are currently studying traditional tales in English and these four girls came in that theme!

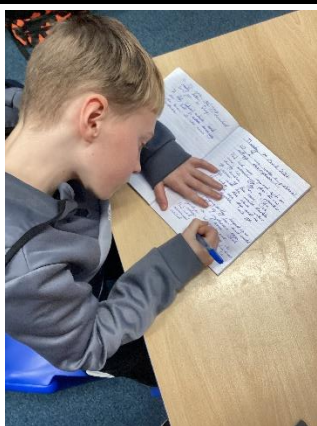

We could certainly count on them to support their friends!



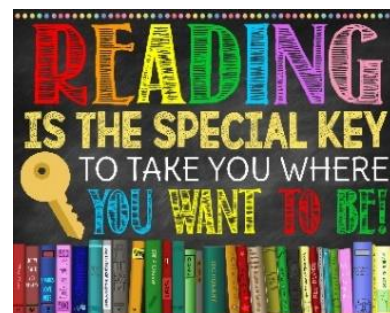

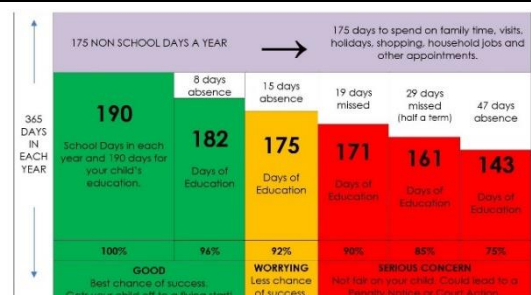
