A polite reminder that dogs are **NOT** allowed anywhere in the school playground.

Governors and staff recognise that dogs are an important part of life for some of our families and, as such, are often included in day-to-day activities such as walking children to and from school. In our teaching we promote the relationship between people and their pets and accept and encourage the idea of pets as 'family members'.

We do see pet ownership as a valuable educational experience for children.

However, many people find the presence of dogs in the playground stressful, even frightening, particularly for younger children – not to mention the mess they can leave! Even well-behaved dogs can behave unpredictably when placed in busy, noisy and crowded school environments and children can also react unpredictably when in the presence of dogs they do not know.

Let's think safety first and obey the rule!

Please note that this rule does not apply to assistance dogs or our Trust Dog Lottie, who has a Risk Assessment in place.
