Year 5: George for consistently demonstrating kindness and care towards classmates. Olivia for her inspiring role-model behaviour both in and around school.

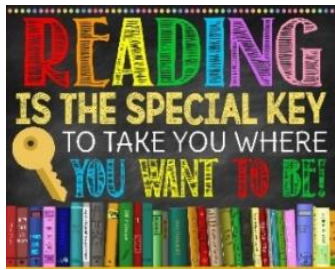
