Special thanks to our Runshaw College Student Emily Purcell for her hard work during her two-week placement!

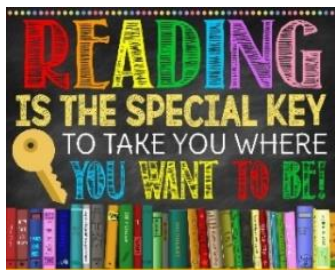


Attendance Counts!
